

Outcomes


- A shared system of prioritisation [primacy rules]
- A cultural shift, especially in attitudes to risk, and
- Ease of participation for consumers
 - or their intelligent energy technologies

And what's needed to deliver these outcomes?

- Gaps in **system intelligence** need to be addressed
- Data interoperability standards, and
- Incentives to encourage investment by some energy system actors so that value can be created by others.


